Internship Rules

1. No use of drugs, alcohol, tobacco, or medical marijuana.

2. No weapons of any kind.

- a. "The weapons we fight with are not the weapons of the world. On the contrary, they have divine power to demolish strongholds." 2 Corinthians 10:4
- 3. No pursuing new romantic relationships between other interns, volunteers, staff members, Mercy House guests, Oasis program men, Refuge @ The Well women, or Five80 employees.

4. No PDA, no sexual activity.
