Mark from a church in Comanche, Oklahoma reached out to Arron after doing a grocery outreach through the Food Ministry. This is what He said:

"We had a really good group come out. It actually included some young people that are not even members of our church, but work with the FCA the middle school. I know that the very first house we went to really needed the groceries, and were looking for a recovery ministry in the area. Denver was able to talk to them about us starting one soon. Another man had just lost her brother last week, and we prayed with her. There were at least three or four other good visits where we prayed with people. The middle school boys have not stopped talking about it all afternoon to many of their friends. They cannot wait until we do it again. One lady who works at a convenience store was commenting this morning to her dad how she had missed the food bank yesterday, and we showed up with bags of groceries today"
