Food Ministry

Here is a current update on the Food Ministry. Arron has been working on making connections with other food distributors that would be willing to partner with Forgotten Ministries to provide us with the food to give out to people in Enid. The Ministry is set to launch on September 1st. He is also working with Autumn to write up proposals to give to churches to partner with them. Here is how we will partner with local churches: We are looking for Churches and groups of individuals who can partner hand in hand with us to spread the Gospel to places our arms can't reach through our Food Ministry. Here's what you can expect from us. Forgotten Ministries will provide everything you need to make grocery bags full of food to take back to your own communities and towns and use to spread the Gospel. We will provide the grocery bags, food, and facility for you to volunteer at to make the grocery bags. Here's what we need from you. We need you to bring a group of people and a trailer or some other vehicle capable of transporting a pallet or two of grocery bags. We need you to dedicate a day to come to the Forgotten Ministries facility to bag the groceries, load them up, and take them back to your church or town. You will be able to use the grocery bags to help provide for your communities needs and more importantly to open up the door to share the Gospel of Jesus with them.
