
During our time in The Gambia, **we engaged** with a wide range of individuals and organizations **to understand the existing challenges and what is currently lacking**. One of the **most urgent needs** identified was support for women and children, especially in helping them reach work or school safely and reliably.

Our approach is built on **long-term sustainability**. We focus on **generating local income and creating self-sufficient systems** rather than relying on subsidies or external aid. Our guiding principle is simple.



The Project in Action

This **transport and micro-financing project** will provide seven-seater vehicles such as the **Seat Alhambra or VW Sharan**. These vehicles will be in use throughout the day, from early morning to late evening, to serve multiple purposes.

They can **transport children to school** in the morning, help **women commute to work**, be used for **commercial pickups** during the day to help fund the project, and then bring passengers **safely home in the evening**.

A major focus of the project is to support **young women** who want to work or start their own businesses. Many face difficulties due to the **lack of affordable and convenient transportation**. By providing vehicles specifically available for them, we offer the opportunity to **earn their own income** while ensuring **safety and consistency** in their daily routines.



Our Commitment

Over the next two years, we plan to deliver two vehicles every six months to the project by supplying :

The cars will be purchased in the **Netherlands**, fully **serviced**, and prepared with **an extra set of wheels, a refurbished air conditioning unit, and a full set of seven seats**.

The vehicles can either be driven to The Gambia or shipped, depending on which method is more cost-effective at the time. **The first delivery will be done by road** to help generate **publicity** and create **engaging content for social media**.

Local Partnerships

Throughout our time in The Gambia, we have built strong relationships with **reliable and passionate individuals** who understand the local context. One of our main partners is **Amadou Jallow**, also known as Ams. He has lived in The Gambia his entire life and currently operates a **driving service**.

Ams is **dedicated to helping local people become self-sufficient**. His passion and commitment are a **driving force** behind this initiative. He sees the project as a way to **empower women**, improve access to **education for children**, and **raise the overall well-being** of the community.

How You Can Help
