



PARENT CODE OF CONDUCT

At Bogdan SKLZ, we believe that a positive, respectful, and supportive environment is essential for every player's development. Parents and guardians play a critical role in creating that environment.

By enrolling my child in Bogdan SKLZ, I agree to uphold the following standards.

I WILL:

- Support my child regardless of the outcome of games or training sessions.
- Encourage effort, learning, and personal growth over winning.
- Respect all coaches, staff members, referees, opponents, players, and families.
- Allow coaches to coach and players to play.
- Demonstrate positive sportsmanship at all academy activities.
- Communicate respectfully and professionally with academy staff.
- Arrive on time for practices, games, meetings, and events.
- Notify coaches promptly of absences or schedule conflicts.
- Support the academy's mission, values, and long-term player development philosophy.
- Represent Bogdan SKLZ with integrity both in person and online.
- Help maintain a safe, positive, and welcoming environment for every family.

I UNDERSTAND THAT:

- Player development is a long-term process.
- Every player develops at a different pace.
- Playing time is earned—not guaranteed.
- Coaches make decisions based on the best interests of the individual player and the team.
- Mistakes are an essential part of learning and development.
- Respectful communication leads to better outcomes than emotional reactions.

I WILL NOT:

- Coach from the sidelines during training sessions or games.

- Argue with referees, coaches, players, or other spectators.
- Use abusive, offensive, discriminatory, or inappropriate language.
- Publicly criticize players, coaches, officials, or the academy.
- Confront coaches immediately before, during, or immediately after games or training sessions.
- Create conflict among players, families, or staff members.
- Engage in bullying, harassment, intimidation, or threatening behavior.
- Post negative or harmful comments about the academy, coaches, players, or officials on social media.
- Interfere with coaching decisions, team selection, or player development plans.

COMMUNICATION POLICY

- Follow the academy's communication procedures.
- Schedule meetings respectfully when needed.
- Allow appropriate time before discussing emotional game-day situations.
- Work together with coaches in the best interest of the player.

CONSEQUENCES

- Verbal warning
- Written warning
- Parent meeting
- Temporary suspension from academy activities
- Removal from games or training sessions
- Suspension of spectator privileges
- Removal of the player from the program without refund, in accordance with the Master Athlete Development, Liability, Payment & Protection Agreement.
