

CELTICS' BRAD STEVENS COMING TO CAPE COD FOR RARE CONVERSATION ON LEADERSHIP, TEAMWORK AND WINNING CULTURE

Two-Time NBA Executive of the Year and Former Celtics Head Coach to Headline Cape Cod Speaker Series Event August 25

BARNSTABLE, MA – One of the most respected leaders in basketball is coming to Cape Cod to talk leadership.

Brad Stevens, President of Basketball Operations for the Boston Celtics, former Celtics Head Coach and two-time NBA Executive of the Year, will appear at the Tilden Center for the Arts at Cape Cod Community College on Tuesday, August 25 at 1:00 PM for “*A Conversation with Brad Stevens*.”

The event will give basketball fans and Cape Cod audiences an opportunity to hear Stevens discuss leadership, teamwork, culture and performance under pressure, subjects that have defined his career from the college sidelines to the Celtics front office.

Before joining the Celtics, Stevens built a national reputation at Butler University, leading the Bulldogs to back-to-back NCAA Championship appearances. He went on to become Head Coach of the Boston Celtics before transitioning to the front office as President of Basketball Operations.

Now, Cape Cod audiences will have the opportunity to hear directly from Stevens about leadership, teamwork and developing a strong organizational culture in one of the most competitive environments in professional sports.

The appearance will close the Cape Cod Speaker Series' 2026 season, which brings nationally recognized leaders and voices to Cape Cod for conversations about issues and ideas shaping the nation.
