4. Your rights

According to the legal regulations, you may, as an entity affected, request information on your personal data stored with the ORCA Industriemontagen GmbH & Co. KG at any time and without any costs. B. Purposes and extent of data processing

1. Website

Processing communication data

Every time a user accesses a web page of ORCA Industriemontagen GmbH & Co. KG and retrieves a file, access data will be stored in a log file on our server about this process. Every data record consists of:

- • IP address;
- • web page from which the file was retrieved (so-called referrer URL);
- • file name;

- • **date and time of retrieval (so-called "time stamp");**

- • **data volume transferred;**
- • **access status (file transferred, file not found, etc.);**
- • **description of the browser type used (e.g. Mozilla Firefox, Google**

Chrome or Microsoft Edge, Apple Safari, Opera etc.

We store the anonymized IP addresses for a period of 2 weeks in server log files. The data is stored for reasons of safety to ensure the stability and the operational safety of our website. Art. 6, Sect. 1 lit. c GDPR is the legal basis for that.

Processing of content data & legal basis

As far as there is the possibility of entering personal or business data (e-mail address, name, address) e.g. via our contact form, the data will expressly be collected on the basis of a voluntary declaration of consent according to Art. 6. Sect. 1 lit. a GDPR. Here as well, your data will be treated confidentially and will not be passed on to third parties without your consent.

This data will not be linked with the communication data.

Recipient of the data

Basically, we do not disclose your data to third parties unless you have consented to that. However, we have to rely on the use of service providers for the hosting and maintenance of our website, with the service providers being obliged to comply with the legal requirements by means of an order processing contract according to Art. 28 GDPR.

Cookies & Tracking
