- The Executive Board of IAFF Local 81 recently attended the IAFF's Affiliate Leadership Training Summit in Los Angeles. Information that is vital to the success of our local was imparted through a myriad of classes.
- Local 81 continues to be active in political action, but we need more members to contribute to PAC fund. The account number is 8633 at Firefighters Credit Union.
- Local 81 is working on getting non-profit status and a challenge coin is being made that members will need to contribute to PAC to get.

- Multiple nominations for PFFU Convention were made. Convention is April 17-19 in Ogden.
- This legislative session's Tier II bill was discussed. This is the number one priority for PFFU this term. Local 81 members are actively working with PFFU on this issue. Membership is encouraged to affirm your support to your elected state representatives.
- SDI issues are ongoing. If you need to use more than 2 shifts when taking SDI, notify your E-Board.

Also- there are some benefit changes. Medical insurance is going up 7% of premium (not pay). This follows PEHP recommendation. In dental, the Periodontal implant benefit increased. New providers are being evaluated for the Salt Lake City Strong Public Safety Enhanced Program. The RFP's for short term and long term providers are up this year. The local will be part of the process going forward.
