- Nominations were accepted for Local 81 delegates to the annual PFFU Convention (Ogden, April 17-19)
- Local 81 continues to be active in political action, and our PAC fund is vital to our success. Members are encouraged to donate (Firefighters Credit Union Account #8633).

- Multiple committee reports. Members are encouraged to participate in Union committees.

- SB 129 (the Tier II bill) was discussed. There has been some late session issues that PFFU is aware of and working through. The legislative session ends on 3/14/19. Membership is encouraged to contact your state representative and express support for SB 129.
