

# E&P Working Principle: Split decision research & decision making

When it comes to decision making, the challenge is the risk of making a wrong decision!

For many big companies the risk of making wrong decisions has a negative impact on reputation and on the time to finally make a decision.

We learned in previous videos that the quicker an organisation makes decisions, the more agile is the delivery.

### **What a dilemma!**

At E&P we believe that the solution to this dilemma is the separation of decision research and decision making.

The separation of the process of decision research from the process of decision making creates transparency and clear accountability.

Experts are responsible for the decision research. They must provide feasible scenarios with statements about risk, impact, and their commitment level.

Decision makers must be legitimately accountable to make final decisions and bear the impact of their decision.

Transparent decision research enables an organisation to openly manage risks. It accelerates the entire decision process, and it has a positive impact on collaboration.
